Litter Kits Now Available at Your Local Library

Ten local libraries in the Blackstone Valley are now offering “litter kits” for patrons to borrow. Each kit has supplies for four volunteers and includes litter grabbers, safety vests, trash bags, disposable gloves, sanitizing wipes and instructions. “Our goal is to make sure everyone is safe while they do a good deed for our environment,” explains Donna Kaehler of Keep Blackstone Valley Beautiful.

We all see trash littering our areas. KBVB, with the support of our local libraries, thought what a great way to help residents borrow the needed equipment to go out and pick this up. “Litter grabbers are the best.
